FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

"On the 5th Sunday of Lent, the Gospel reading tells the story of Jesus and the woman caught in adultery. The religious leaders try to trap Jesus by asking if she should be stoned according to the law. Instead of condemning her, Jesus responds with wisdom, saying that whoever is without sin should throw the first stone. This challenges the leaders' hypocrisy, as they are quick to judge her while ignoring their own sins. One by one, they walk away, realizing their own faults.

This story from the 5th Sunday of Lent teaches us about mercy, forgiveness, and avoiding hypocrisy. Jesus shows compassion to the woman, encouraging her to leave her life of sin without condemning her. This reminds us not to judge others harshly, as we all have our own weaknesses. It challenges us to be honest about our own faults and to show mercy and understanding to others.

Heavenly Father,

As I enter another week of my Lenten journey, guide me to the path that leads to you. Fill my heart with gratitude, patience, strength, and peace as I strive to become the best-version-of-myself. Let me hear your voice in the deepest reaches of my heart. Give me rest in you. Help me to accept others, showing them your great love instead of casting judgment. Stay with me through the busy days this week and remind me that when I need comfort, solitude, wisdom, or guidance, I can always turn to you. Amen.
